Funding: New & Old Programs/Annual Appropriations Process

• New:

- Chesapeake WILD (US FWS) [\$4 million in FY22)
- Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (aka, bipartisan infrastructure bill, enacted November 2021)
 - EPA Chesapeake Bay Program (\$238 million over 5 years)
 - Clean Water SRF (\$11.7 billion over 5 years)
- USDA Chesapeake Bay States' Partnership Initiative (\$22.5 million in FY22)
- Old/Existing Programs:
 - EPA Chesapeake Bay Program (\$88 million in FY22)
 - Farm Bill Conservation Programs + Conservation Technical Assistance (\$904m in FY22)
- Proposed Legislation
 - SEEE Act NOAA Chesapeake Bay Office Reauthorization Bill (H.R. 3540/S. 1816)

Chesapeake WILD – US Fish & Wildlife Service

 September 2019 - Legislation introduced by Senator Chris Van Hollen (D-MD) and Congressman Bobby Scott (D-VA)

October 31, 2020 – Became law

• March 2022 – FY22 Omnibus Approps bill funds the C-WILD at \$4m

September(?) 2022 – first round of projects should be announced

EPA Chesapeake Bay Program

- FY22 \$88 million
 - \$9.625m for SWG
 - \$9.625m for INSR
 - \$7.25m for MEB
- IIJA (Bipartisan Infrastructure Law) Supplemental Funding FY22 \$47.6m
 - \$15m for SWG
 - \$15m for MEB
 - \$10m for INSR

Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF)

- FY22 \$1.6 billion (\$353m for the 7 Bay jurisdictions)
 - MD \$38.8 million
- FY22 Additional \$1.9 billion in IIJA Funding (\$410m for the 7 Bay jurisdictions)
 - MD \$45m
- EPA Guidance on IIJA CW SRF, issued in March 2022
 - 49% of IIJA CW SRF funds grants or loan forgiveness for "disadvantaged communities"
 - 10% for Green Project Reserve

USDA Chesapeake Bay States' Partnership Initiative (announced on May 6)

- This is a named program Good√
- Utilizes unspent/unobligated FY21 funds
- \$22.5m for Bay watershed conservation on farms in FY22- Good ✔ □
 - \$10m through EQIP
 - \$10m through ACEP
 - \$2.5m through CSP
- No guarantees of permanence or continued funding
- CTA funding increased to \$904 in FY22
- 2023 Farm Bill? RCPP?

SEEE Act – NOAA Chesapeake Bay Office Reauthorization Bill (H.R. 3540/S. 1816)

• Authorization expired in 2007.

Current funding level is about \$9 million

• SEEE Act would authorize funding for the NOAA CBO at \$18.7 million in FY23 up to \$22.6 million in FY25.
