- Expanded our Board and acquired new talent
- Adjusted nimbly to the pandemic by offering more webinars on climate, conservation, and collaboration featuring national and state leaders in the land conservation movement. (Webinar participation, across the state, exceeded our expectations.)
- Increased our work in **advocacy** by; becoming the fiscal sponsor of *Partners for Open Space*, drafting and submitting 10 pieces of testimony on state conservation legislation, and testifying virtually in support of land conservation and environmental legislation impacting preservation goals and efforts.
- Led the Land Trust Alliance Lobby Days Maryland team, April 20th 21st
- Expanded Maryland Environmental Trust's Keep Maryland Beautiful
 Grants Program and, in conjunction with our partners, awarded over
 \$300,000 to 91 nonprofits, land trusts, and municipalities to support
 and protect natural resources in urban and rural areas. (We also
 introduced a new platform for applicants and the grants committee to
 apply, score and allocate awards.)
- Supported two efficient and effective Regional Conservation Partnerships in Maryland.


